Port of Mobile

Transportation Advantage

- 45-ft Ship Channel at McDuffie and Choctaw Point; 40ft. Ship Channel at Main Port Complex
- 33 Nautical Miles to Sea Buoy and the U.S. Intracoastal Canal
- Unencumbered Access – No Overhead Obstructions
- Adjacent to I-10 and I-165/I-65
- 5, Class 1 Railroads: CSX, Canadian National, Burlington Northern/Santa Fe, Norfolk Southern & Kansas City Southern
- Two Class I Intermodal Rail Terminals (CSX and CN) Adjacent to Port
- Class 3 Short Line Railroad and Switching Yard for all Class 1 Carriers (On Port)
- Class 3 Railroad Operating a Ferry Service to Coatzacoalcos, Mexico Sailing Every 4 Days.

- Grade Separated, Dedicated Rail & Truck Roadways; Adjacent to Air Cargo Terminal – Brookley Airfield, Mobile Airport Authority
- Adjacent to I-10 and 3 Mi. from I-65
- Capacity 600,000 TEUs
- Dedicated Value Added Warehousing and Distribution Areas

ZIM Lines A New Carrier Service to the Port

- Zim Lines will provide shippers with world-class container service from Mobile to North and South Asian ports, the Mediterranean, South and Central America, as well as the Caribbean.
- Cargo lifted at the Port terminal will be relayed to Zim worldwide, mainliners at Kingston, Jamaica, Zim's offshore North American hub. The route is as follows: Kingston - Tampa - Mobile - New Orleans - Houston - Kingston.
- The Zim Caribe, Zim Mexico, and Zim Houston are capable of carrying up to 1,150 TEUs.
